

## ARGO WOMEN WALLOP WALLA WALLA

**GREAT FALLS** – The University of Great Falls Women’s basketball team, off a tough loss to conference leading MSU-Northern, took on the visiting Lady Wolves of Walla Walla University in a non-conference match up. The Argos were on a mission as they walloped the visiting Wolves 96-53.

“It was a great effort tonight by the ladies.” Coach Bill Himmelberg said. Kindra Jones tallied fourteen points. Mary Wilmore and Kezia Ford both contributed eleven. Khayla Gladney had ten for to raise the tally to four Argos in double digit scoring. The Argos shot 57 percent from the floor, fifty two percent for treys and seventy five percent from the free throw line.

“We played well as a team and really shared the ball with some great passes and terrific assists.” Himmelberg added. Every Lady Argonaut found the basket. In the rebound department the Lady Argonauts were very aggressive pulling down twelve offensive and thirty seven defensive rebounds for a total of forty nine. “I am really proud of the way we went after the glass.” Himmelberg concluded.

The Lady Wolves were led by Sarah Fitch who chalked up a double-double with twelve points and eleven rebounds. With the victory the Lady Argonauts improve 5-8 on the season and with last night’s loss to MSU-Northern they are 0-1 in conference action.

The two teams are on the floor Sunday at 1:00 pm for the final non-conference game for both squads.
