

ARGONAUTS GRAB FIRST FRONTIER CONFERENCE VICTORY

BILLINGS – The University of Great Falls Men’s Basketball Team has always been close in the first three games of the Frontier Conference. Head Coach Steve Silsby told the Great Falls Tribune, “We do not need to reinvent the wheel; we need to simply adjust a spoke or two.” That is what the Argos did this evening against Rocky Mountain College in a Frontier Conference match up.

The Argos were led by Marcel Towns who posted a double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds. Melvin Williams led all scorers with 19 points. Leon Sutton tallied 15 for the Argos. The Argonauts shot 46 percent from the floor to capture their thirteenth win of the season.

“I am really proud of my team.” Head Coach Steve Silsby said. The Argos led by 10 at half (36-26), behind .500 percent shooting from the floor, .308 from three-point land, and .400 from the Free Throw line.

“Tonight, was a great team effort.” Silsby continued. The Argos pulled down 37 rebounds. The Battlin’ Bears were led by John Bayo who tallied 13 points. “My staff did a great job of getting the team ready to play this week.” Silsby concluded.

The Bears fall to 9-10, 2-2 in conference while the Argos improve to 13-6, 1-3 in conference. Next up for the Argos is a trip to Helena to take on the Saints of Carroll College while the Bears host Montana State University-Northern.
