

## [Argo Grapplers Wrap Up Home Season with 15-point Win](#)

**GREAT FALLS** – The University of Great Falls Wrestling Team completed the home portion of their 2011-2012 wrestling season with a 27-9 victory over Wyoming's Northwest College.

The Argos, ranked number three in NAIA, lost a 4-point meet to the same team on January 13<sup>th</sup> in Powell, Wyo. "Tonight was the senior's night to shine." Head Coach Caleb Scheaffer said. The Argos honored six seniors who will be graduating in May in a pre-match ceremony. Seniors were accompanied by parents, siblings or close friends as they received a commemorative fame with photos of each senior in action during their career as an Argonaut.

In the first match, at 131 lbs, Argo senior Luis Carranza, from Idaho Falls, Idaho fell to Justin Gardner in a 3-0 decision. At 141 lbs, Spokane, WA senior and current number one wrestler in the NAIA, Anthony Varnell, wrestled against his former school and beat Colton Thornton by a decision and tying the score. The evening was highlighted by Norwalk, Calif. senior Juan Enriquez pinned Sean Sullivan.

"I am proud of the seniors. They wrestled well and this meet was a good way to honor them. They stepped up to the challenge and wrestled well." Scheaffer added.

The Argos finished their home schedule with a 5-1 record losing to, then number 1 ranked, Southern Oregon by a single point in a terrific 19-18 dual. The Argos are on the road early Thursday morning, heading for a very busy weekend.

Thursday they are in Western Wyoming. Friday they wrestle a dual at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Ariz.. On Saturday they travel to Grand Canyon University for the fourth dual in five days. "This is going to be a very busy weekend. We now have our eyes on the first three days in March and are working to be our best at the National Tournament." Scheaffer concluded.
