

Argonaut Men Open Tournament with Eighteen Point Loss

LAS VEGAS – The University of Great Falls men’s basketball team suffers its second loss of the season falling to the Lancers of California Baptist University 59-77.

Coming off a loss to NCAA Div I Brigham Young University, the Lancers of Cal. Baptist were led by Aleksander Milovic who paced all scorers with nineteen points. The Argonauts, who have spread the scoring around in previous games, were led by Melvin Williams who, with twelve points, was the only Argonaut in double figure scoring.

Sophomore Marcel Towns paced the Argonaut rebounding with ten. Luke Evans, Cal Baptist, led all rebounders with twelve. “We were just not shooting the ball like we have in the past.” Coach Steve Silsby said.

The Argonauts fall to 11-2 on the season and return to the hardwood tomorrow at 8:00 pm against Daemon College of New York. The Argonauts conclude the tournament on Friday against California State University at San Marcos at 6:00 pm. The Argos open 2011 Frontier Conference play on January 6th against Montana State University-Northern.
