

Argos Back to their Winning Ways

LEWISTON, Idaho – The University of Great Falls men’s basketball team turned the ship around and is back to their winning ways beating Lewis & Clark College of Ore. 86-73.

Led by Phoenix, Ariz. Sophomore, Marcel Towns who led all scorers with 21, the Argos had to rally from a first have five point deficit to win by 13 and improve to 9-1. Melvin Williams, a Philadelphia, Pa. junior, pulled in 7 rebounds for Steve Silsby’s Argonauts. “It was a good effort tonight.” Silsby said. “They were able to bounce back from a tough loss last weekend.”

The Argos suffered their only loss of the season by a single point to Black Hills State on Dec. 10 at Carroll College.

The Argos shot .589 from the field in the game and .421 from beyond three-point land. They also shot an impressive .750 from the Free Throw Line. That Argos bench chipped in eleven points. The Argos tallied ten point off of fast breaks, eighteen off of turnovers and fifteen second chance points.

The Argos will spend Friday night in Lewiston and play Quest University on Saturday. The Argonauts return to the friendly atmosphere of the McLaughlin Center on Monday evening to host the Wolves of Walla Walla University. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:00 pm.
