

Argonaut Melvin Williams Selected as Player of the Week

WHITEFISH, Mont., Jan. 23 2012 — Melvin Williams of the University of Great Falls was named the Frontier Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week. Williams is a 6-foot-2, junior guard from Philadelphia, Pa. Great Falls went 2-0 on the weekend winning on the road at Carroll College 60-51 and at Rocky Mountain College 75-61.

Williams averaged 18 points, six rebounds, and 2.5 assists per game. He was 13 of 23 from the field (57 percent) and 7 of 10 from the free throw line. He had 17 points and six rebounds against Carroll as UGF scored their first win over Carroll since rejoining the Frontier Conference in 1999.
