

## **Number 6 Lewis-Clark State Trip Lady Argos**

**GREAT FALLS** – The University of Great Falls Lady Argo basketball team played with the NAIA 6<sup>th</sup> ranked Lewis and Clark State College but in the end the Lady Warriors prevailed in a 59-51 Frontier Conference victory.

The Lady Argos were led by Chelsey Adams who scored 12 points and pulled down 4 rebounds. Lindsey Abramson led the Argos with 10 rebounds and tallied 7 points. The Argo bench contributed 15 points to outscore the Lady Warriors bench by 3.

“I am proud of the way we keep getting better each game.” Head Coach Bill Himmelberg said. The Lady Argos shot .283 from the floor (17-60), .318 from beyond the arc (7-22) and .714 (10-14) from the Free Throw line. “We played better in transition tonight.” Himmelberg added as the Lady Argos scored 17 points off of turnovers 3 points more than their counterparts.

“We rebounded better tonight.” Himmelberg commented. The Lady Argos trailed the NAIA #6 ranked Lady Warriors by one in the rebound department (40-39). “Our rebounding allowed more second shots.” Himmelberg said. The Argos tallied 15 second chance points, seven more than the Lady Warriors.

With only a two points difference for the Points in the Paint stats the Warriors had 18 to the Argos 16. “They proved why they are ranked as high as they are, and they are a good team.” Himmelberg concluded.

With the loss the Lady Argos fall to 1-6 in the Frontier Conference and 7-13 overall.

The Lady Argonauts have a week off before hosting Montana State University-Northern on Saturday evening at 5:00 pm (This is a time change from the original schedule) in a rematch of the season opener on January 6<sup>th</sup> in Havre where the Lady Argos fell 55-47.
