

Lady Argos Fall to Div II Idaho State in final Exhibition Game

POCATELLO, IDAHO – The University of Great Falls women’s basketball team fell to Division I Idaho State University 86-42 in the final exhibition game for the Argos.

The Lady Argos started out sluggish trailing the Bengals by twenty-seven at the half. The Argos more than tripled their first half effort but ended up short in the final score.

The Lady Argos were led by senior Kezia Ford who scored ten points. Freshman Lindsey Abramson pulled down a game high seven rebounds for the Argos.

The Bengals were led by Kaela Oaks who had a game high nineteen points. Jessica Jensen led the Bengals with five rebounds.

On the game the Argonauts shot 33 percent from the floor, forty-five percent from three-point land, and thirty-six percent from the free throw line.

ISU shot forty-nine percent from the floor, thirty-seven percent from beyond the arc and twenty-five percent from the charity stripe.

“We started very slow tonight.” Bill Himmelberg said. “I am proud of the effort the girls gave in the second half.” Himmelberg concluded.

The Lady Argos celebrate the New Year with a pre-season game against Mount Royal on January 1st at 5:30 pm in the McLaughlin Center.

The Lady Argonauts open Frontier Conference play in Havre against MSU-Northern on January 6th.
