After one season as the team's head coach, Paul Zazenski led the Argos to their first conference championship along with a berth to the 2010 NAIA National Tournament in only the programs fourth year. The Argonauts then earned a trip to the NAIA "Sweet 16" after defeating #2 ranked Simon Fraser in the round of 32. To cap off the season, the Argonauts were honored with a NAIA All-American, 2 All-Region players, 1 Conference Player of the Year, and 4 All-Conference performers. Zazenski was named Conference and Region Coach of the Year after leading UGF to a record of 16-4-1.

As a kid growing up in Atlantic Beach, NC, Zazenski was a member of the state championship Greensboro Soccer Club. He played three years for the North Carolina ODP state team while making the Region III ODP pool and helping the North Carolina team to a runner-up finish in the ODP National Championship.

Zazenski played four years of collegiate soccer at the NCAA Division I level for the University of North Carolina-Greensboro. While at UNC-G, he was a part of the Spartans' back-to-back Sweet Sixteen appearances in the NCAA Tournament. During his junior season, Zazenski helped UNC-G compile an 18 game winning streak and a national ranking of number one for most of the season. Zazenski played along-side three NCAA Division I All-Americans. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in exercise sports and science from UNC-G.

PHILOSOPHY

The UGF high school soccer camp will be based on the Brazilian Philosophies and focus on advanced team training with emphasis on the tactical aspects of the game. Possession, penetration, offensive and defensive balance and support, team shape, systems of play and many other important topics will be covered. Yet, as the Brazilian Philosophy dictates, the fundamentals of the sport are also highly emphasized (i.e. dribbling, passing, receiving, finishing, heading, etc.).
