### **Great Falls 4 x 800 Meter Relay Team Finishes 10th**

**Geneva, Ohio** – The University of Great Falls indoor track team traveled four student-athletes to the GaREAT Indoor Sports Complex to participate in the 2011 NAIA Indoor Track and Field National Championships starting today. The UGF men's 4 x 800 meter relay team consisting of Ander Jayo, Travis Price, Jimmy Sliwa, and Austin Stuchell (all sophomores) went into the competition ranked 12<sup>th</sup> in the nation.

Running 10 seconds faster than their qualifying time, the relay team finished fourth in their heat and 10th overall with a time of 7:48 in the preliminary race. Unfortunately, the team missed advancing to the finals by a mere three seconds.

"I am extremely proud of our guys," said head coach Jim Brewer. "They competed well and improved their overall time by 10 seconds. This was especially impressive as Travis (Price) has been struggling with a bad cold this week. We hope he can also run well tomorrow in his open race."

Price is the lone Argo indoor track and field athlete to qualify individually in an event. Price qualified for the 800 meter run at the Montana State University Open with a time of 1:55.75. Prelims for the 800 meter race are set to begin at 4:30 pm (CST) on Friday.
