### **Argos Cage the Cougars**

**Great Falls, MT** – The University of Great Falls men’s soccer team ousted the visiting Colorado Christian University Cougars this evening by a final of 3-1 at Siebel Soccer Complex. The win moves the Argos to 5-1-1 on the season.

“It was not the best game we have played this year but we got the result,” said **Head Coach Paul Zazenski**. “We really struggled in the final third today, however, we had some players step up and get us the goals we needed.”

The Argos controlled the first half but could not find the back of the net until **Ben Freiborg (Huntington Beach, CA)** received the ball on top of the 18 yard box, juked two defenders and sent the ball sailing into the upper right corner at the 43<sup>rd</sup> minute mark. **Christain Johansen (Drammen, Norway)** would add the second goal for the Argos 15 seconds before the break when he placed in a nice header off of a cross from **Jesus Mendez (Bonners Ferry, ID)**.

The Cougars got their only goal early into the second half on free kick taken by Grant Terzian. With the wind behind him, Terzian sent the ball into the Argo box where it bounced by several defenders and attackers and ended up in the back of the net.

The Cougars would try to use the wind to their advantage the rest of the second half but the Argos would cap the scoring on a **David Jimenez (Long Beach, CA)** goal in the 76<sup>th</sup> minute. Jimenez took a pass from **Ryan O’Neil (Arima, Trinidad)** just inside the box and blasted the shot into the back of the net to put the Argos up 3-1.

**Zach Johnson (Casper, WY)** recorded five saves on the day, all in the second half. The Argos outshot the Cougars, 25-12 and held 9-5 shots on goal advantage. The Argos would end the day with an astonishing 11 corner kicks while not conceding one to the Cougars.

The Argos will take on the Jimmies of Jamestown College tomorrow at 2 pm following the women’s game at 12 noon at Siebel Park.
