### **Argos Cap Road Trip with a Win**

**Caldwell, ID** – The University of Great Falls men’s soccer team capped their three game road stint with a 3-1 win today over the host College of Idaho Yotes. Junior midfielder **Alex Martinez (Long Beach, CA)** led the way for the Argos as he provided one goal and two assists.

“I am very pleased with our effort today,” stated **Head Coach Paul Zazenski**. “We needed this win and the team stepped up and proved that they wanted it, especially in the second half.” Zazenski’s squad outshot the Yotes 9-2 in the second half.

The Argos got on the board in the 14th minute as Martinez lofted a corner kick to the far post which found **David Jimenez (Long Beach, CA)** flicking home the goal. The Yotes would get a lucky break in the 17th minute as the Argos tried to clear the ball from the box but a defender headed it back into the goal to equalize the score.

The game would remain tied until 21 minutes into the second half when Martinez played a nice through ball to **Ryan O’Neil (Arima, Trinidad)** who blasted a shot into the right corner of the goal. The goal would mark his third of the season.

Martinez would add a goal of his own in the 75<sup>th</sup> minute off a rebound from a shot by O’Neil. The Argos held a 15-5 shot advantage over the Yotes and notched five corner kicks while College of Idaho had two.

The Argos (4-1-1) will host Colorado Christian University on Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm in Great Falls, MT. The next day, September 12, the men will take on the Jimmies of Jamestown College at 2 pm following the women’s game at Siebel Park.
