UGF Softball Gets Commitments From 2 JUCO Transfers

Jirrels comes to UGF after a two-year career at Chandler-Gilbert Community College in her native Chandler, AZ where she was a 1st Team All-Region selection in 2009. The diminutive Jirrels should prove to be a valuable utility player with her ability to play both infield and outfield. In her time at Chandler-Gilbert, she appeared in 70 games while batting .277 (46-for-166). She also scored 24 runs and drove in 37 more. A graduate of Chandler High School, Jirrels plans to pursue a secondary education degree.

"I have met with Kelsey numerous times and she is very excited about our program," said Ehnes. "We believe that she will be a great fit for our team which has high expectations for next season."

Great Falls, MT – University of Great Falls softball coach **Gary Ehnes** has announced the signing of **Chloe Scudder** and **Kelsey Jirrels** to NAIA/Frontier Conference Letters of Intent today. Both Scudder and Jirrels come from out-of-state and will enroll in classes this coming fall.

Scudder, a 5'11" pitcher originally from Twain Harte, CA, is a graduate of Summerville Union High School where she was one of the greatest hurlers in the school's history, and architect of one no-hitter during her senior year. Most recently, Scudder pitched for the College of San Mateo in 2008, where she led the Bulldogs in games pitched (36), games started (33) innings pitched (187.1) and strikeouts (109). She posted a 16-17 record that season and pitched 20 complete games. She plans to be an art major at UGF.

"Chloe comes from the 'Jimmy Dyson stable' and her 5'11" stature is sure to intimidate a few hitters," Ehnes said. "I expect her to contribute immediately in our quest to reach nationals next year."
