Men's & Women's Basketball Fall to Montana Tech

Butte, Mont. – The Lady Argos' four-game winning streak was stopped short tonight as the Lady Diggers of Montana Tech handed them a 57-74 loss. Great Falls, which is off to one of the best starts in recent history, went down early and struggled to regain momentum.

Tech held the Lady Argos top scorer, Kezia Ford, to 10 points. Freshman Sarah Sciascia had another good game off the bench to lead Great Falls with 19 points which accounted for one-third of the team's total offense. Ford did lead the team in rebounds with eight and steals with three.

The Lady Argos (9-9, 2-1) will host Rocky Mountain College next Friday and 22nd ranked Carroll College on Saturday. Tipoff is set for 5:30 pm both nights.

The University of Great Falls men's team saw its worst offensive performance of the year as they lost to the Diggers 40-55. Senior Mark Celaya came off the bench to lead the Argos with 12 points.

The Argos continued their cold shooting making only 31 percent of their field goal attempts. Tech shot almost 49 percent on the night. Both teams were almost even in every other statistical category including rebounds, turnovers and steals.

Great Falls is now 0-3 in league play and 7-11 overall.

Great Falls will also host Rocky Mountain College next Friday and Carroll College on Saturday. Game time is set for 7:30 pm both evenings.
