#11 Lewis-Clark State Take Argos in Three

Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls Volleyball team was slow to get anything going early into the match against the Warriors of Lewis-Clark State College and would lose in three straight sets. The loss drops the Argos record to 5-12 on the season and 2-3 in Frontier Conference play.

The first set saw the Argos missing many passes and struggling defensively. However, things would turn around in the second set as the Argos found themselves tied at 15 with the 11th ranked Warriors. The Warriors would rally six straight points, eventually winning 25-18.

The Argos would jump to a quick 10-3 lead in the third set. Sophomore **Maggie McCall (Billings, MT)** and junior standout **Tosha Nunes (Fallon, NV)** provided the Argos with the much needed firepower accumulating a combined nine kills. The Warriors' attack would be too much to handle for the struggling Argo defense as Lewis-Clark came back to tie the set at 22 apiece and go on to win 25-22.

Sophomore **Kila Adams (Camas, WA)** had 16 of the Argos 17 assists. Junior **Kali Schmidt (Whitefish, MT)** and **Kelsey VanUden (Thousand Oaks, CA)** lead the Argos defensively with eight and seven digs respectively.

The Argos will travel to Helena, MT next Thursday, September 30 to take on the Saints of Carroll College. The Argos will then play the Rocky Mountain College Battlin' Bears on Saturday, October 2 in Billings, MT.
