Argos Sweep the Jimmies

Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls men’s and women’s soccer teams made a clean sweep of the Jamestown Jimmies this afternoon by winning their respective matches at Siebel Soccer Complex. The women kicked things off with a 2-1 win while the men topped the afternoon off with a 7-0 routing of the Jimmies.

The Argo women got on the board in the opening minute of play with a Great Falls connection goal. **Jenell Jackson (Great Falls, MT)** received a ball from the midfield and slotted an open **Ashlee Henry (Great Falls, MT)** who knocked home the first goal of the game from six yards out. The Argos would continue to dominate play the rest of the half but were unable to find the net again.

The Argos would concede a goal seven minutes into the second half when Hannah Langseth outpaced the Argo defense and tucked the ball away for the only Jimmie goal on the day. **Jean Escobar’s (Garden Grove, CA)** late goal from 20 yards out in the final minutes of the game would lift the Argos to a 2-1 victory on the day.

“It was a good win for our team,” said Head Coach **Brian Clarke**. “We needed this victory going into conference play next week. I was proud of our team and their determination to be victorious today.”

The Argo men would follow in the same footsteps as the women and notch a win against the Jimmies. They would waste no time getting the scoring kicked off in route to a 7-0 win.

Ryan O’Neil (Arima, Trinidad) received a bouncing ball from **Alex Martinez (Long Beach, CA)** and rocketed a volley off the far post for the opening goal at the seven minute mark. **David Jimenez (Long Beach, CA)** would add the second Argo goal five minutes later off an O’Neil and **Miguel Mendez (Bonners Ferry, ID)** assist. Jimenez put in another 23 minutes into the game from a pass from Mendez just inside the 18 yard box. **Patrick Jones (Whitefish, MT)** would round out the scoring in the first half in the final seconds of the first half with his first goal of the season.

The Argos would again score early into the second half as Martinez would find the feet of **Juan Pina (Santo Domingo, Domingo Republic)** who tucked the ball away for the fifth Argo goal. **William Obregon (Managua, Nicaragua)** and **Pedro Chavez (Long Beach, CA)** rounded out the scoring at the 60 and 67 minute for the Argos.

“I was very pleased with our result today,” stated Head Coach Paul Zazenski. “We put together a full 90 minute game and played the kind of soccer we are capable of playing.”

Argo women are scheduled next to travel to Westminster September 19 and the men will take on Rocky Mountain on September 23 and Westminster on September 25. The women will return to Great Falls on September 24 to take on Minot State and the men will be home next to take on Rocky Mountain on October 1.
