Women's Soccer Comes Up Short

Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls women's soccer team took action this afternoon against the Griffins of Westminster College but came up short of the win. The Argos (2-11) went into the break tied at zero with the Griffins (10-6-1) before relinquishing the game winning goal two minutes into the second half. Westminster would go on to win 1-0 in the two teams' second meeting of the season.

Heather Hillam got the goal for Westminster when she played a free kick into the box which found its way through a crowd and into the back of the net. The Argos would come up with several good scoring chances late in the game but were unable to find the equalizer. Freshman **Megan Walburn (Maple Valley, WA)** recorded seven saves on the day for Great Falls. Westminster outshot the Argos 8-3 on goal and had seven corner kicks to the Great Falls' 4.

"I thought the team worked hard today and put forth a good effort. Westminster is a good team and I felt like we gave ourselves chances to tie the game after they scored early into the second half," stated **Head Coach Brian Clarke**.

The Argos will be in action again on Tuesday, October 26 when they travel to Billings, MT to take on the Battlin' Bears of Rocky Mountain College. Kickoff is set for 3 pm.
