UGF's Chytka, Hollen & Stevens Named NAIA Scholar-Athletes

Great Falls, MT – Seniors **Kelsey Chytka (Laramie, WY/Laramie High School)**, **Randi Hollen (Chattaroy, WA/Chattaroy High School)** and **Katie Stevens (Missoula, MT/Hellgate High School)** of the University of Great Falls women's soccer team were among 387 student-athletes selected as 2009 Daktronics-NAIA Women's Soccer Scholar-Athletes as announced by the NAIA.

"I am proud of these three young ladies and their achievements in the classroom," said **UGF head coach Brian Clarke**. "Katie is a two-time recipient which is quite an outstanding accomplishment. I have no doubt these three will be just as successful beyond college."

Nominated by each institution's head coach, a student-athlete must maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale and have achieved junior academic status to qualify.

Chytka, a biology major, has been a three-time Dean's List honoree as well as being team captain of the Lady Argos for three consecutive seasons. She posted career highs this past season with two goals and two assists.

Hollen, though just a junior eligibility-wise, has chosen to forego her final season of competition as she will graduate with a degree in business administration. 2009 proved to be a difficult season for Hollen as she battled injuries throughout the second half of the season. She did appear in 13 contests this season and had two assists.

Stevens also battled injuries for much of 2009 as she appeared in eight games, scoring her first career goal from her striker position on October 17 against Southwestern College (AZ). She is now a two-time recipient of this honor, as Clarke eluded to as she carries a dual major in history and sociology while also carrying a minor in government.
