### **Montana Western Bests Lady Argos**

**Great Falls, MT** – The University of Great Falls Lady Argonauts fell to 0-4 in conference play tonight as the University of Montana Western Lady Bulldogs handed the home team a 70-60 defeat. In the process, the Lady Bulldogs (5-13, 1-4) picked up their first conference win of the season.

“We had a chance tonight,” said UGF head coach Shawn Chaffin. “The game was closer than the final score indicates but they just out-executed us down the stretch.”

The Lady Argos battled back from an early deficit and took a 29-26 lead into the halftime intermission. However, they experienced a slow start to the second half and Montana Western regained control. The Lady Bulldogs came out firing, hitting 16-of-32 from the field in the second half, after shooting just 30% in the first stanza.

Senior Kristen Luedtke (Butte, MT) paced the Lady Bulldogs with a game-high 21 points on 7-of-11 shooting from the field. Freshman Rheanna Padden (Thompson Falls, MT) chipped in 10 points while fellow freshman Alecia Wilson (Helena, MT) took only one shot from the field, which she made, but made her presence felt with six assists.

Stasia Holden (Arleta, CA) led the Lady Argos with 14 points, nine rebounds and four blocked shots. Local product Kirilynn Winkler (Great Falls, MT) added 13 points and seven rebounds while McKenzie Gentry (Pocatello, ID) knocked down three of the team’s five three-point baskets and finished with 11 points. Kassie Holmlund (Great Falls, MT) chipped in with nine points, seven assists and three steals.

The Lady Argos return to the court tomorrow night at 6pm when they host Montana Tech.
