#2 Vanguard Puts On Clinic Vs. Lady Argos

Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls women's basketball team found themselves on the wrong end of a 112-61 decision at the hands of the #2 Vanguard Lions on the second day of the 2009 Townhouse Inn Classic. With the loss, UGF falls to 0-8 on the season while Vanguard, who played the likes of Stanford and Connecticut tough in their preseason exhibition schedule, moves to 4-0.

"We were just overmatched today," said **UGF head coach Shawn Chaffin**. "They (Vanguard) weren't at their best in their win last night (against MSU-Northern) and I think they took it out on us this afternoon. They were awfully, awfully good today against us. We did some nice things out there but it obviously wasn't enough."

Senior guard **Diana Neves (Gladstone, Australia)** led six Lions who reached double figures with a game-high 24 points, including 6-for-13 shooting from beyond the three-point arc. The Lions also got solid efforts from **Rachel Copeland (Dexter, OR – 18 points, five rebounds)**, point guard **Bridgette Reyes (Tustin, CA – 16 points, 10 assists)** and **Alexandra Halberg (11 points, five assists, four rebounds)**.

Jaclyn Blied (Fullerton, CA) came off the bench to score 18 points while grabbing a team-high six rebounds as well for Vanguard. Reserve guard **Sarah Boyd (Oregon City, OR)** chipped in with 13 points and six assists.

The Lady Argos were once again led by junior guard **Kristy Henderson (Aurora, CO/Northeast Junior College)** who put in 18 points on 5-of-10 shooting from the field in just 20 minutes of action. Junior forward **Katie Wright (Cedaredge, CO/Hannibal-LaGrange College)** came off the bench to score 11 points and was the only other Lady Argo to reach double figures.

The Lady Argos are now idle until an exhibition contest against the University of Montana on Dec. 6 in Missoula. UGF will travel to Lewiston, ID for the Wells Fargo Invitational on Dec. 11-12 where they'll face Lewis-Clark State and Pacific Union before finishing the road trip by facing Walla Walla University on Dec. 13. The Lady Argos return home on Dec. 20 to face the University of Alberta.
