Great Falls Dominant in Battle of the Rockies Open

Great Falls, MT – The University of Great Falls wrestling squad hosted their annual Battle of the Rockies Open today at Charles M. Russell High School. The Argos wrestled well in front of their home crowd capturing four championships, two runner-ups, and four third place honors.

Seniors Akmal Adilov (125), Ross Mosher (165), Michael French (184) and sophomore Myles Mazurkiewicz (141) each won the championship matches in their weight classes. The three seniors each won their match by a close decision while Mazurkiewicz pinned his opponent 2:03 into the first period. Michael Hader and Juan Enriquez finished as runner-ups at 157 and 285, respectively.

Juniors Luis Carranza and Noah Hatton won their last matches of the day to take third place at the 133 and 174 pound weight classes. Sophomore Brian Borst and freshman Ryan Martin, who both wrestled unattached, took third at 125 and 141 pounds.

“We wrestled really well today,” exclaimed head coach Caleb Schaeffer. “To have four individual champions, considering the high-caliber wrestlers here, says a lot about how we did.”

Team awards were not given out but scores were kept throughout the open. Third ranked Great Falls took the top spot with 147 points, followed by #2 McKendree (117) and #4 Missouri Valley (114.5).

The Great Falls squad will hit the mat again next Friday, December 10 when they dual Yakima Valley Community College in Yakima, WA. The dual is set for 5 pm (PST). The next day the Argos will participate in the Highline Open in Highline, WA.
