UGF Wrestles to a Draw with MSU-Northern

Havre, MT – It was not pretty but it was not a loss either for the University of Great Falls wrestling squad. The sixth ranked Argos tied Montana State University-Northern tonight, 24-24, in a dual that saw both programs winning five matches. MSU-Northern entered the night ranked 13th in the nation.

MSU-Northern started the night off with a forfeit at the 125 pound weight class. Sophomore **Myles Mazurkiewicz (Havre, MT)** would keep things rolling for the Argos at 141 pounds with a 12-4 major decision over Ryan Shelstad. Junior **Anthony Varnell (Spokane, WA)** dropped a close match, 2-3, to Anthony Weerheim at 149 pounds.

Sophomore **Michael Hader (Columbia Falls, MT)** got things back on track for the Argos as he pinned Cody Miller at the 1:58 mark. Senior **Ross Mosher (Augusta, MT)** would follow Hader's lead and rolled through Gary Anthony at 165 pounds with an impressive 17-2 technical fall win.

The match of the night came at the 184 pound weight class where Great Falls' number one ranked **Michael French (Malta, MT)** topped number two Evan Hinebaugh, 2-1.

The final two weight classes went to the Lights as **Levi Morgan (Springfield, OR)** lost 1-3 and **Juan Enriquez (Norwalk, CA)** lost by fall 6:47 into the match.

"We have to get better," explained head coach **Caleb Schaeffer**. "Bottom line, we have to get better!"

The Great Falls' squad will have a day off before wrestling in the Spokane Open on Saturday, November 20 in Spokane, WA. Following the Spokane Open, the team will take action next at home on December 3 and 4 for the Battle of the Rockies Duals and Open.
