### **Mazurkiewicz Named To AWN All-Rookie Team**



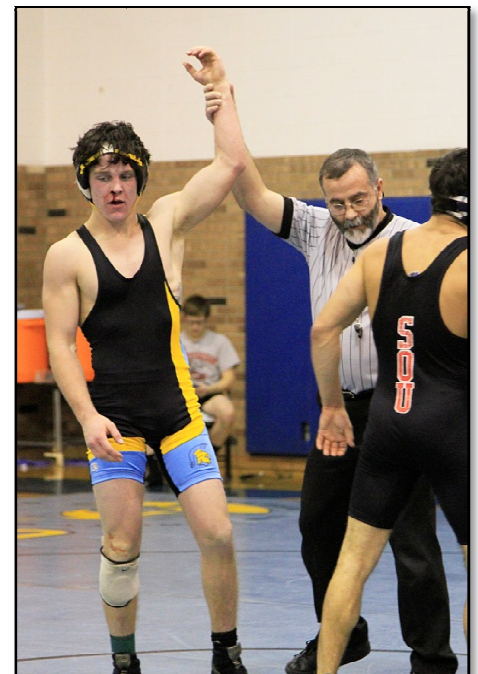
**GREAT FALLS, MT** – University of Great Falls freshman wrestler Myles Mazurkiewicz (Havre, MT) has been named to the 2010 *Amateur Wrestling News* All-Rookie Team in the 133-pound division.

The *Amateur Wrestling News*' All-Rookie Team features wrestlers from all three divisions of NCAA competition as well as the NAIA. The publication ranks the top six in each weight class and lists other notables as honorable mentions. Mazurkiewicz is the number five-ranked rookie grappler in his weight class, according to the publication, and one of just four wrestlers from the NAIA ranks to receive the accolade.

Mazurkiewicz had a memorable first season with the Argos as he notched a 30-9 record with 13 pins. He put together a dominant run this past March at the 53<sup>rd</sup> Annual NAIA Wrestling National Championships in Oklahoma City, advancing to the 133-pound final with two wins by pin-fall and two more by major decision, before bowing to Tommy Pretty of Campbellsville University (KY). This followed his runner-up finish at the NAIA Western Regional Tournament in his hometown

of Havre, MT.

Mazurkiewicz helped UGF to a 15-3 dual record, giving the Argos the most dual wins of any NAIA team in the nation, as well as their highest national finish (#3) in program history.
