Skylights Halt Argos Win Streak

Havre, MT – The University of Great Falls Argo Volleyball Team (#25) fell to conference foe Montana State University-Northern in 5 games at the Armory in Havre.

The Armory is always a difficult venue to play in for visiting teams. Tonight was no exception. The Skylights battled at home to win the first game by 2 and the second game by 4. The Argos had to play catch up. A position they have not been in very much this season.

The Argos were led offensively by Junior Kelsey Van Uden who slammed 25 kills to the Armory floor. Defensively for the Argos Kyah Piva had 26 digs. On the other side of the net the Skylights numbers were less impressive yet consistent enough for the win. Offensively the Skylights were led by Hillary Isleifson who had 12 kills, less than half of the number Van Uden posted. On defense the Skylights 16 digs were credited to Holly Cartwright.

“They came out ready to fight” Head Coach Arunas Duda said. “We battled but fell behind the first 2 games. Our ladies played really well to even the match. We simply came up short in the 5th.” We learned some things about ourselves tonight. We have to play better as we get deeper into conference play. We are more than capable. We learn, we move on.” Duda added.

The loss drops the Argos to 17-2 overall and 2-1 in Frontier Conference play. The road ahead is far from easy. The Argo travel to Lewiston, Idaho on Thursday to battle 11th ranked Lewis-Clark State College. On Saturday the Argos will be in Salt Lake City, UT to take on Westminster College.
